



## International Admissions Checklist | FNT (Fitness and Nutrition Trainer)

Students who are not fluent in English must demonstrate English proficiency by submitting at least one of the following:

- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 55 or higher on the internet based test. Visit [www.toefl.org](http://www.toefl.org) for more information on the TOEFL. Applicants holding a baccalaureate or advanced degree from an accredited college or university in the U.S. are exempt from the TOEFL requirement.
- IELTS English Proficiency Exam band score of '6' or greater. Visit [www.ielts.org](http://www.ielts.org) for more information.
- Evidence of Graduation from an English speaking secondary institution.
- Evidence of having completed 12 semester hours or 18 quarter hours with at least a C (70%) average at a postsecondary institution where English was the language of instruction.
- Evidence of completing an intermediate ESL course with grade of C or better

In lieu of these standards of English Proficiency, the school may consider admittance of a student who provides a letter of recommendation from a fluent English educator who attests to student's ability to:

- a.) Achieve an 'A' in a class taught entirely in English, and
- b.) Converse in English and sign employment agreements in English without translation.

Assuming that the student is fluent in English or proficient in English by evidence of the above, the following is a checklist of what is required for admission to the school:

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As an international student attending the American Fitness and Nutrition Academy, you agree to the following :

1. I will check-in with the school upon entering the United States and before the start of my program.
2. I agree to provide the school with my active email address and all active phone numbers while residing in the United States.
3. I will immediately report to the school any change of address while I am residing in the United States.
4. If I decide to travel outside the United States while a student at AFNA, I must obtain a signed Form I-20 from the school's international student representative. If I do not, I may not be granted re-entry to the United States.
5. I must maintain full-time status as a student at AFNA. If I fall below full-time hours, I may lose my status as an M-1 Student.
6. I must notify the school if I am unable to attend class for any reason. I must remain fully compliant with all school policies, including those related to attendance and satisfactory academic progress.
7. I understand that I may not work while I am enrolled at AFNA under the auspices of my M-1 Student Visa program.
8. I understand that AFNA is in contact with the Student Exchange and Visitor Program (SEV-P) through the Student Exchange and Visitor Information System (SEVIS). The school is required to share with SEVIS all pertinent information related to my program and my residence while attending the school. This information may affect my M-1 Student Visa status.
